Does anyone get paid? The music director, guest musicians and substitutes for Amy do get paid.

Does the choir sing at other events? Not mandatory, but we are invited as individuals to sing at other UU and interfaith events such as Vigils, Fundraising Concerts, Holiday Fair, Memorial services, Juneteenth, Frederick Douglas State-Wide Reading, and more.
